It can be added to The Ghan or Indian Pacific for private charters available between Adelaide, Perth, Alice Springs and Darwin.

The Chairman's Carriage boasts a private lounge with CD player and video/DVD entertainment, a private dining room and sleeps up to eight in comfort with two Double Cabins and two Twin Berth Sleeper Cabins (upper & lower berth).

The Sir John Forrest Carriage features large picture windows, a generous lounge area combined with a meeting room complete with boardroom table, bar, leather lounges, big screen television, video/DVD player and power point screening facilities. This carriage accommodates up to six guests in one Double cabin and Two Twin Berth Sleeper Cabins (upper & lower berth).
