

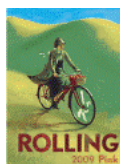
## AUSTRALIA



**2008 Best's Bin No. 1 Shiraz, Grampians, Victoria.**  
The wine is brimming with concentrated mulberry and ripe plum flavors and there is a hint of spice on the finish.



**2005 Majella Sparkling Shiraz, Coonawarra, South Australia**  
The inky dense ruby purple color is an indication of the concentration of fruit. The aromas are smooth and luscious cassia, dark plums and chocolate coated licorice.



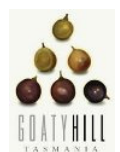
**2009 Rolling Pink - Central Ranges, NSW**  
It's a serious Rose; with lots of color, ripe strawberry and hints of cool climate leafiness. Chilled, it's an absolute outstanding drop to see you through entrée to dessert.



**2008 Burnbrae Viognier - Mudgee, NSW**  
This is a typical cool climate Viognier showing restrained spiciness on a delicate floral nose. Hints of Granny Smith apples greet the palate which has a lovely mineral acidity which points to a wine which will age.



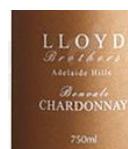
**2008 Clairault Semillon Sauvignon Blanc - Margaret River - Western Australia**  
Pale straw in color, with aromas of melon and passion fruit, fresh basil and lemon rind. The palate is delicate and refined. Quite dry with a gentle and well balanced acidity.



**2008 Goaty Hill Riesling - Tasmania**  
Immediate bold pink grapefruit characters tempered with complex tropical fruit tones. Hints of lemon and lime provide depth of flavor to a well-structured and balanced wine. Natural acid backbone ensures length of flavor.



**2008 Mount Horrocks Cordon Cut Riesling - Claire Valley, South Australia**  
Medium gold-colored, possessing a beautiful bouquet of peach, apricot, & tropical aromas. With vibrant acidity & a stylish personality, it has Auslese-level sweetness & impeccable balance.



**2007 Lloyd Brothers Bonvale Chardonnay - Adelaide Hills, South Australia**  
The nose of this delightful Chardonnay has great complexity displaying spice, oatmeal and sweet-fruit aromas. The palate has plenty of white peach & melon flavors and has balance.



**2007 Petersons Mudgee Shiraz - Mudgee, NSW**  
Lovely deep ruby color with purple highlights & has a nose of ripe plum, blackberry and pepper. The grippy tannins are well matched by concentrated spicy berries, plums and aniseed flavors. that linger on



**2007 Pike and Joyce Pinot Noir - Adelaide Hills, South Australia** Offers smoky meaty tones, game meats & barrel ferment-derived characters. Crunchy lively fruit carries across the palate with vibrant dark cherry flavor, balanced neatly with bright acidity.

## NEW ZEALAND



**2005 Auntsfield Long Cow Sauvignon Blanc - Marlborough**  
A touch dull with some hardness on the palate. Some passion fruit and red capsicum. Nice balance - finishes dry and very slightly bitter.



**2005 Babich Black Label Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc** Developed to complement food. - Babich blended a wine which, while displaying the pungent & crisp characteristics that set Marlborough sourced fruit apart, shows greater depth and complexity on the palate.



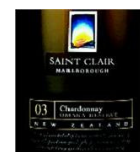
**2005 Cape Campbell Limited Edition Reserve Chardonnay** A full bodied wine where the fruit flavors are supported by underlying nutty spicy oak notes. The palate is very full, elegant, and creamy with soft acidity that leads to a warm lingering finish



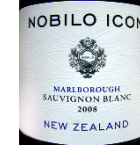
**2005 Grove Mill Sauvignon Blanc - Marlborough** An elegant blend of tropical overtones - passion fruit, mandarin, peach & a hint of the herbaceous with basil characters. Intense flavors of pineapple, grapefruit and gooseberry.



**2008 Mt. Difficulty Pinot Gris - Central Otago**  
Aromas of white peach and nectarine. The palate displays luscious fruit in the same vein, while the mid palate is full, creamy and well textured. The wine has a rich grapefruit driven finish.



**2005 Saint Clair Sauvignon Blanc - Marlborough** A full and crisp, powerful wine with intense flavors of passion fruit, blackcurrant, underlying gooseberry and herbal tones. Mouth-watering acidity is balanced by a full yet elegant palate that leads to a long lingering finish.



**2008 Nobilo Icon Sauvignon Blanc - Marlborough**  
A brilliant burst of lime, grapefruit and green apple rides easily on a racy, acidity-fueled texture, persisting into the long vibrant finish with hints of wet stone and citrus peel.



**2006 Wither Hills Pinot Noir** A wonderful core of ripe dark smoky plum, & dense rich brambly forest fruits command the aromatics, the tannins are silky, and acid balance sublime, adding structure and weight to the leather spice, cocoa



**2005 Villa Maria Private Bin Sauvignon Blanc - Marlborough** Lifted ripe guava, passion fruit and tropical aromas. The palate is lively and refreshingly balanced, punching with fruit intensity and lingering crispness.



**2004 Villa Maria Reserve Pinot Noir - Marlborough** The alluring bouquet is perfumed with an array of dark and red cherry fruit and subtle spicy clove notes. The complex palate is elegant and layered, displaying refinement and silky texture. A classic Marlborough Pinot Noir.
