



## Spirit of the Outback

The Spirit of the Outback takes guests on a journey experiencing the true Australian outback. This fascinating 24 hour trip between Brisbane and Longreach provides an adventure that takes guests to the home of the famous Australian Stockman's Hall of Fame, Qantas Founders Outback Museum and Heritage Centre.

This train service has been a favourite with Australian and international travellers alike for over 14 years, due to the social atmosphere onboard and spectacular views during the journey.

### Sleeping accommodation

Choose between travelling in a single, twin or triple sleeping berth. The sleeping berth includes:

- Private cabin that provides a seat by day and sleeper by night
- Washbasin, wardrobe, full length mirror, reading lights and power point (240v AC)
- Panoramic views
- Air conditioning
- Full linen (except top sheet in triple sleeper)
- Showers and toilets are conveniently located at the end of each carriage.

### Seating

For the budget conscious traveller, economy seats are available with tray tables, reclining seats, foot rests, window shades and overhead reading lights.





### Dining Car

Aboard the Spirit of the Outback, guests can enjoy authentic Australian dining by experiencing one of the deliciously hearty Aussie sit down meals available from the à la carte menu. Meal packages are available for pre-purchase.

### Lounge Car

The lounge car on the Spirit of the Outback is perfect for a relaxing drink and chat with fellow travellers. A wide range of Queensland and Australian beer, wine and refreshments and light snacks can be purchased.

### Club Car

Choose from a selection of take away meals, snacks and beverages on offer. Movies are also shown in the Club Car.

### Other outback services

Queensland Rail also operates additional outback services.

The Westlander operates twice weekly between Brisbane and Charleville and The Inlander operates twice weekly between Townsville and Mount Isa. Both services offer a range of sleeping and seating options and a meal and snack service from the Club Car.
