





## **New Zealand Electronic Travel Authority (NZeTA)**



- All US/Canadian Passport holders require an NZeTA to enter or transit in New Zealand
- The NZeTA allows you to enter New Zealand without out a visa for stays up to 3 months.
- There is a NZ\$17.00 charge for the NZeTA on the free app or NZD\$23 if completed online. You must also pay a NZ\$35.00 International Visitor Conservation and Tourism Levy (IVL), for a total cost of NZ\$52.00 (NZD\$58 online).

- We encourage travelers to apply for an ETA at time of deposit to prevent any unnecessary last minute delays
- In most cases, you will be notified of the result of your application within 10 minutes, however, there occasionally may be a delay of up to 72 hours.

#### **COVID Information**

### New Zealand no longer requires visitors to be vaccinated.

Please check with your airline or cruise provider as they may still require proof of vaccination. If you have COVID-19 symptoms when you arrive in New Zealand by air, you are encouraged to take a rapid antigen test (RAT).

## Should you test positive for COVID during your stay:

- You must register your positive test result <u>here</u> as soon as possible to connect you to the best care and recovery plan appropriate for you.
- You must self-isolate in your accommodation for 7 days.
- · You may leave isolation on day 8.
